Digital transformation strategies should include clear priorities, implementation roadmaps, responsible actors, measurable indicators and regular monitoring.

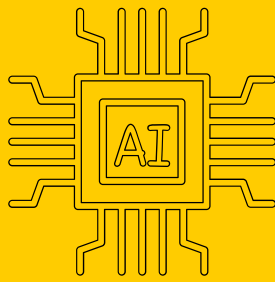

Digitalisation should reduce inequalities rather than reinforce them.

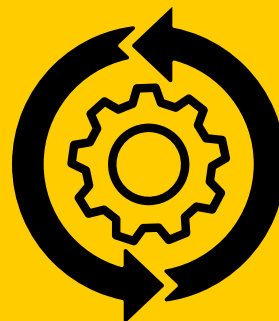

Higher education institutions should establish clear frameworks for the ethical and responsible use of artificial intelligence in teaching, learning, research, administration and student support.

Each higher education institution should develop a digital continuity and resilience plan covering campus closure, infrastructure damage, energy disruption, loss of connectivity, cyber incidents and displacement of students and staff.

Sustainable digital transformation requires continuous professional development for academic, administrative and managerial staff.

Financing

Fundraising should be integrated into institutional digital development strategies rather than treated as a series of isolated projects.
