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1 Background

1.1 The Project

TOUR-X is a Centre of Vocational Excellence (COVE) Project for the Tourism Industry (Project Id: *ERAS-MUS -EDU-2021-PEX-COVE 101056184*) which envisions to create excellence in Tourism through a bottom-up approach where the Education providers of the partnership will enhance their ability to adapt skills provision to everchanging economic and social needs.

The TourX project, co-funded by the European Union is led by a Consortium of 23 experienced partners representing the most prominent VET providers, the Tourism sector and Regional Authorities of the seven countries that the project brings together. Moreover, TOUR-X is going to establish partnerships on a regional level, titled Knowledge Triangles in Germany, Greece, Italy and Spain, four of the leading countries in the Tourism sector of Europe. The Knowledge Triangles are gathering VET providers, representatives of the business sector and public authorities in order to better collaborate and contribute to regional development in the Tourism sector.

2 The assignment

2.1 The purpose

The purpose of the assignment is to establish all the actions, procedures, measures, indicators, and systems that will secure the quality of the outputs and processes, allowing their close and continuous monitoring and reviewing during TourX lifespan. The Evaluation mechanism optimises the internal communication procedures of the consortium, to ensure the quality of project outputs and to safeguard high quality of the deliverables.

Evaluation has linkages with all Work Packages of the TourX project, and complements Project Management, throughout projects lifespan, involving all partners in a collaborative way. More specifically, it provides the necessary information to manage the project's quality in all its life cycle, from planning to implementation and evaluation.

2.2 Tasks

The assignment includes:

2.2.1 Evaluation methodology and reporting

Task 1: Drafting of an Evaluation Methodology

The Contractor is going to focus on:

- The evaluation of the planned expectations of the project.
- The evaluation of the ongoing implementation of the project.
- The evaluation of the Cooperation process within the Partnership

Based on the above mentioned the Contractor will develop the Evaluation methodology of TourX project. The Evaluation methodology will include the forthcoming evaluation questions that will be used for the contribution to the quality assessment:

- criteria relating to the relevance of the project (relevance of objectives for the success of a project, selection / documentation of the best strategy or approach to be applied for the implementation).
- ii. **criteria relating to the coherence of the project**. What the project specifically wants to achieve and what it provides for as to this.
- iii. criteria relating to the effectiveness.
- iv. **criteria relating to the performance of the project activities** (proper use of resources in comparison with the objectives and results achieved, outputs performed).
- v. **criteria relating to the sustainability**. That is, are the results long lasting? Will the results continue after the end of the project?
- vi. **criteria relating to the usefulness of the project** (evaluation of the impact of the project).

Task 2: On going and final evaluation

Two evaluations will be conducted during TourX lifespan. The mid-term evaluation report is of vital importance to identify possible areas of improvements. The mid-term evaluation report aims to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of project's implementation. Upon that ground, we are going to include a clear set of SMART indicators for measuring the achievement of planned expectations. In addition, a satisfaction survey is going to be implemented case by case having both qualitative and quantitative tools for the training courses.

The external evaluator will be responsible for the mid-term and final evaluation. In detail, the external evaluation of the Project comprises the following components:





- **External evaluation of the entire project:** production of mid-term evaluation and final evaluation reports.
- **Peer reviews and inter-project coaching** with relevant Erasmus+ projects will be carried out via videoconferencing or meetings in person.

2.3 Deliverables

The following Deliverables are going to be asked to be prepared and submitted within this assignment:

- Evaluation methodology (Deliverable 1)
- Mid-Term (Deliverable 2) and
- Final Evaluation (Deliverable 3).

2.4 The timeline

The total duration of this assignment is 38 months, starting on the 1st of April 2023, while the timeline for the delivery submission of the deliverables is the following:

Should the TourX Project be extended, due to the decision of the Partnership and / or the European Commission, this assignment will be extended for the same duration without any increase of its budget, while some deliverables will be delivered at a new deadline, which will be agreed at a Partnership Level and announced at least 1 month in advance to the Contractor.

3 Value of the assignment and payments

Subject to the final grant agreement between the European Commission and the lead partner and the bilateral agreement between the lead partner and BK Consult GmbH, a maximum total of 16,000.00 Euros is available for the purpose of this project for the tasks described above including all taxes (e.g., VAT, costs for attending meetings, etc.). The final amount will be paid depending on the contractor's previous experience in relation to the above tasks and the financial offer submitted. Sub-contracting is not allowed.

Payment of the assignment will be made in three instalments as listed below:

- i. <u>A first instalment</u> amounting to **40% of the total value** of the contract is going to be paid after signature of the contract during the second month of the implementation period, if Deliverable 1 will have been submitted and approved by BK Consult GmbH.
- ii. <u>A second instalment</u> of **30% of the total value** of the contract is going to be paid on Month 18, if Deliverable 2 will have been submitted and approved by BK Consult GmbH.

5 Content and presentation of the bids

The proposals should contain a detailed explanation of the qualifications and the expertise of the potential contractor, e.g., information on references from the contractor on similar projects already handled, to demonstrate his/her experience and capability to succeed in performing the tasks as set out in section 2.2 of this Request for Proposals.

In detail, potential Contractors, should submit the following documents:

7 Evaluation process – Award Criteria

Aside from the above stated requirements, the selection process will be based

1) on acceptance of the tender offering the best price quality ratio and 2) on the availability during the project duration for the requested tasks. The Contractor is selected according to the standards of selection that have been developed by BK Consult GmbH. Main selection criteria are the expertise and capacity to deliver the work tendered for, the price quality relation, the methodological quality and the tenderer's work experience. It should be noted that the contract will not be awarded to a tenderer who receives less than 70% on the award criteria.

In detail, the following criteria are going to be considered:

- Evidence tracks record of proven scientific research experience and extensive knowledge of Social Inclusion (with reference to education as well)
- Proficient capacity of the English languages (additional European languages such as German and Greek are an asset)
- Understanding of the nature of the assignment
- Capacity to work in a team project
- Ability to meet deadlines
- Ability to meet budget allowance
- Availability to attend meetings

Within this context, the evaluation process includes the following steps:

- The submission date and time of all tenders is checked, and all tenders having been submitted after the submission deadline are rejected.
- The requirements of Section 0 are checked and any tender that does not fulfil the essential requirements is rejected.
- The technical proposal (methodology and tools used) is being assessed.
- The following score system is going to be used for the evaluation of the Tenders:

- The Financial Offers for all evaluated tenders are opened.
- The final ranking of all offers is prepared by using the following formula: 70% X the score under technical requirements / 30% the score under the financial proposal.





- The most preferred candidate is contacted and asked to sign the contract.
- All other candidates are informed about the evaluation results, if requested when submitting the offer.

Note: when signing the contract, additional statements may be required to avoid incompatibility or conflict of interest.

8 Applicable Law

The contractual agreement is based upon and regulated by the European Commission's rules, provisions and requirements as set out in the project agreement with the European Commission, DG EAC and applicable German and Land Brandenburg Procurement Law. The Contractor is obliged to fulfil the described tasks and duties of work to receive the final payment according to the contract.

BK Consult GmbH has the right, based on German Law, to terminate the contract when the Contractor cannot perform the agreed tasks and duties accordingly.

Any conflicts of interests or disputes concerning the validity of this arrangement, the construction of its terms, and the interpretation of the rights and duties of the parties in the contract shall be governed by German Law.

Article 4





Value of Contract and Payments

Article 9

Force Majeure - Penalties - Termination of the Contract

In the event of challenges or circumstances beyond the control of one of the two parties, that shall make it impossible to meet its obligations of one to the other, as provided by this agreement, that party must notify the other party in written, explaining the situation that does not allow them to further fulfil the obligations emerging from this contract. This written statement must be made as soon as the event takes place, or the circumstances arise. The performance of the obligations of this Contracting Party shall be deemed to be postponed until the events or circumstances permit their resumption under the same terms herein. Within this context, should both parties agree, a mutual termination of this Assignment shall be possible.

In all other cases, should the Contractor fail to submit deliverables at the requested date as foreseen in Article 2 of this Contract, a penalty may apply of a total value of 100 € per day of delayed submission. The application of the penalty falls on the discretion of BK Consult GmbH.

Article 10 Other general clauses
