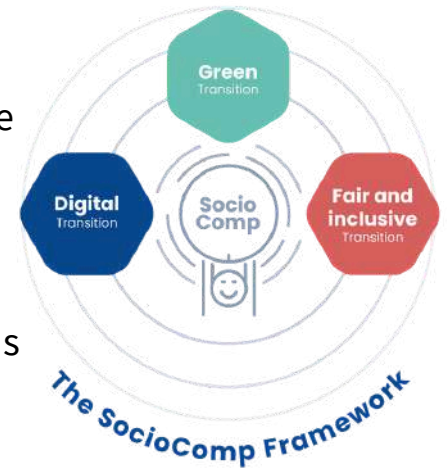

Social Economy Competence Framework

A structured competence framework outlining the **skills, knowledge and attitudes** SEOs need to respond to the triple transition, evolving from **foundation to advanced level**.

It is organised around three interconnected transition areas:

- **Green Transition**, embedding sustainability and systems thinking
- **Digital Transition**, from basic digital use to ethical and strategic innovation
- **Fair & Inclusive Transition**, integrating inclusion into governance, management and business models.



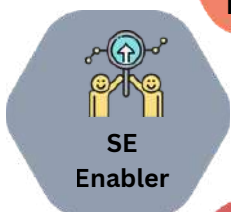

Occupational Profiles

4 crucial roles to navigate the triple transition

Alongside the **SocioComp**, four essential profiles aligned with **ESCO and EQF** were identified to support the ecosystem:

- **SE Manager**, setting ethical principles, strategic planning and sustainable management.
- **SE Enabler**, with a primary focus on organising, managing, and overseeing the specific services of SEOs.
- **SE Supporter**, an external consultant and/or expert closely connected with SEOs, bringing specialized knowledge and expertise.
- **SE Worker**, demanding not just technical skills, but also a profound commitment to the values and principles of SE.

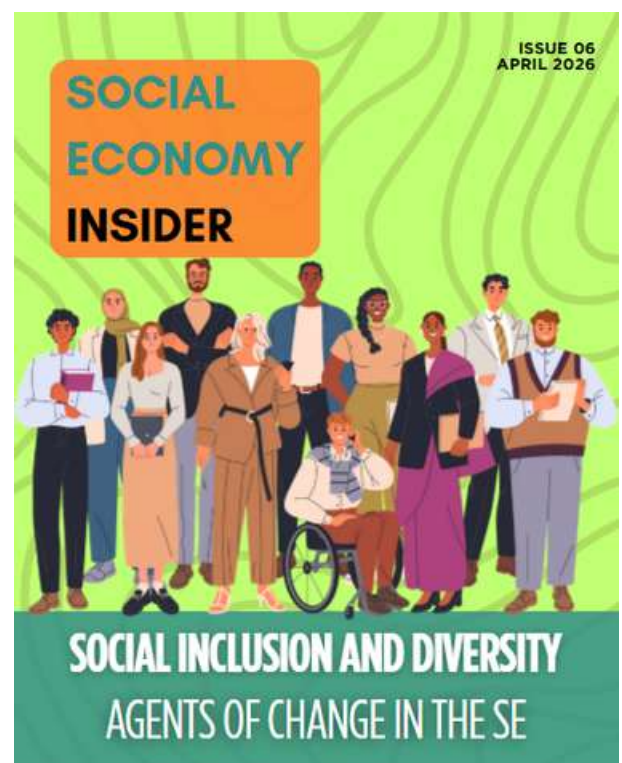
